### **Festival Amadeus single tickets released to public**

Glacier Symphony and Chorale announced today they have opened single ticket sales for the weeklong Festival Amadeus Chamber Music event August 2-8, 2010 in Whitefish and Kalispell. They may be purchased on the Website (<http://www.gscmusic.org/>) or by phone at (406) 257-3241.

Tickets are now offered for the range of concerts and events which include three Chamber Nights featuring such artists as pianist Joel Fan, flutist Heidi McGee and harpist Lorna Krutzen performing with the Glacier and Bridger String Quartets, as well as the two Orchestra Night concerts and a performance with a baroque style orchestra with modern dance by the Karin Stevens Dance Company of Seattle. Tickets to the opening night "Evening with the Artists", a special event to allow a chance for the public to meet the artists in an informal setting are also available.

Individual Chamber Night tickets are priced at \$20 adult, \$18 senior, and \$10 youth. Concerts are held at the O'Shaughnessy Center in Whitefish. Orchestra Night tickets are \$30 adult, \$28 senior, \$15 youth. Orchestra concerts will be held in the Christian Center sanctuary in Kalispell.

Single event tickets are available for the opening night "Evening with the Artists" reception on Monday August 2, for \$ 35 all ages.

A Festival Amadeus transferable pass for the week of music concerts is also available with two pricing options. Adults pass is \$130; senior pass is \$120 and youth passes are \$60. A Pick Four pass is offered \$99, \$89 and \$40 respectively.
